## Recreation Updates:

- **Clarissa- Recreation Coordinator Recognition:**
  - Clarissa is outstanding! Despite the challenges in this busy season, she has consistently demonstrated exceptional dedication, efficiency, and a positive attitude. She quickly adapted to managing multiple tasks and I am incredibly grateful to have her on our team.
  
- **Katie- Recreation Specialist:**
  - We've welcomed Katie into the Recreation Specialist position as our previous specialist, Maddie, graduated from Sac State last week and will be beginning her teaching career.
  - Katie has worked in Aquatics here at the CSD for nearly 4 years, and we're so excited to see her grow in this new position.
  
- **New Programs (Contract Classes):**
  - Pickleball Tournament:
    - We launched our first Pickleball Tournament Saturday, May 25<sup>th</sup>. We sold out and it was a success!
    - 4 volunteers will be helping with this event.
  
  - Zumba:
    - Launched in April and reached 19 total participants with our 20 max in the first month.
  
  - The Reality of Our Mortality:
    - New and free senior program that also launched in April and served 14 seniors in their end-of-life planning.
  
  - Yoga:
    - Between 2 Instructors, we will be offering 3 styles of Yoga in June to target young adults and seniors.
  
  - Youth Ballet:
    - We've welcomed in a Ballet Instructor who has been an instructor with us for other youth dance programs.

- Taekwondo:
  - Cameron Park Family Taekwondo has become an Instructor and is looking to provide youth/adult workshops, free teambuilding exercise for our staff, a demonstration performance at Summer Spectacular, and leading a few demonstrations for our Summer Camp.
  - Interested in being a sponsor and/or community partner.
  
- Artsy Squirrel Camp:
  - Two Instructors (a married couple) will be leading an Art Camp this summer that coincides with our Summer Camp themes and weeks to be consistent.
  
- Summer Camp:
  - Recreation Staff and our Receptionist are bringing new themes, curriculum, and ideas to summer camp this year to really revamp and make our summer camp safer and more successful.
  - Summer Camp is from 12:00pm – 5:00pm this summer to push for more registrations in our morning specialty camps represented through Artsy Squirrel Camp and National Academy of Athletics.
  - Nine staff members hired for 2 cohorts per week – 3 staff per cohort, 1 rotating staff for breaks and 2 staff for weekly rotation and administrative help
  
- **Aquatics :**
  - Swim Lessons
    - Changed the format from 2 week long segments to 1 week segments so those who are improving can move on to the next class faster
    - Working with ALL lifeguards to get into teaching lessons with more methods to learn
    - Hired 20 lifeguards to allow for having more 4-6 hours shifts in a day.
  
  - Aquasol and Sharks
    - Working to fix their Memorandum of Understanding including hours of use and rates for the season
  
  - Recreation Swimming
    - Swim will happen Monday-Thursday for 2.5-3 hours in the afternoon and on two evenings per week for an hour
    - Looking to have a “Film and Float” night in the middle of summer
