 - The Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 requires that an annual Engineer's Report is prepared by a licensed professional engineer and establishes other requirements for the continuation of the assessments. This Resolution directs SCI Consulting Group to prepare the engineer's report for the Cameron Park Community Services District (CPCSD) Landscaping and Lighting Districts for fiscal year 2015/16.
- Resolution No. 2015-02 Directing Auditor of El Dorado County to Levy and Collect Assessments for the Fiscal Year 2015/16 Attachment I
 - O In 1985, AB1350 was passed allowing the CPCSD to enforce Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions (CC&Rs) for each subdivision within the District and to assume the duties of the Architectural Review Committee. That same year, the voters authorized the District to adopt and levy a special tax of up to \$12 per year on each parcel of land within the District.
