# **Weed Abatement Program Update**

The Weed Abatement Specialist has completed updating of the Vacant Lot Database and updating Assessor's Parcel Number (APN), property address and owner name on the Weed Abatement Inspection Spreadsheet, created new labels for each existing folder and all folders for new lots have been added to database. For each file, added the 'Weed Abatement Inspection Form' (for documenting information) along with current APN information, owner information and map of each parcel. Approximately 380 lots.

The Weed Abatement Specialist has called potential Weed Abatement vendors and emailed information sheet with requirements to have them on our list. Waiting for feedback to begin creating a Vendor list for our in-house use in the coming year.

Visual inspections have begun of each vacant lot listed on the Weed Abatement Spreadsheet. Photos are taken of each parcel and information documented and filed for each lot inspected. So far to date there have been 105 inspections.
