



## Cameron Park Fire Department Operations and Administration Report

- On April 30th, 2024, B2715, T2726, E89, E28, E84, E86, E283, and M86 responded to a residential structure fire on western road within station 88's first due area. Upon arrival, E89 reported a single-story house with a working kitchen fire and smoke visible from the front of the structure. Shortly after, CAL FIRE T2726 arrived and assumed command of the incident. Fire personnel on scene executed an aggressive fire attack and successfully contained the fire to the kitchen. No injuries were reported, and the cause of the fire was unintentional.
- The CAL FIRE Amador El Dorado Unit has secured a commercial building located at 3421 Palmer Drive in Cameron Park (former Eskaton). This facility will serve as the Ponderosa Fire Center, accommodating seven firefighter hand crews. These crews will be available for local, regional, and statewide responses to wildland fires and all-risk emergencies. Daily staffing at the center will include up to 60 personnel, comprising fire captains, engineers, and firefighters.

## **Cameron Park Fire Department Prevention Report**

- Cameron Park Fire staff, alongside CAL FIRE Ponderosa Fire Center, EID, and EDC County DOT, have met to address hydrant clearing and road access clearances for fire apparatus. The three agencies are taking a task force approach to addressing the vegetation and clearing issues. A tentative plan is set for the last two weeks in May to begin the work.
- A defensible space candidate has been selected and will begin onboarding the week of May 6th. This inspector will start performing defensible space inspections throughout the community in the coming weeks, continuing until July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- The aerial pyrotechnic display application for the Summer Spectacular was received, reviewed, and a permit was issued to the vendor.
