#### Recommendation

Staff is recommending the Fire Prevention hourly rates remain the same for 2020 (Attachment 1A) and hours charged per service also remain the same (Attachment 1B).

#### Discussion

Fire Prevention fees had not increased for many years. In late 2018, Fire Prevention staff studied staff salary and supply costs and recommended a significant increase from \$65/hour to \$165/hour for calendar year 2019. If contracted Fire Prevention services are used, the property owner is billed for the Fire Department time plus the contractor costs plus an administrative fee.

#### Conclusion

Due to the significant increase in fees for 2019, and fees currently recovering costs related to the Fire Prevention program, staff is not recommending a fee increase for 2020.
