Maintaining Proper Defensible Space

- Remove all dead plants, grasses, weeds, and dried leaves.
- Remove all tree branches at least 6 feet from the ground.
- Create vertical and horizontal spacing between shrubs and trees.
- Keep tree branches 10 feet away from your chimney.
- Remove vegetation and items that can catch fire from around all structures.

Fire Resistant Landscaping

Use rock, mulch, flowerbeds, and gardens as ground cover for bare spaces and as effective fire breaks.

Choose fire-retardant plant species that resist ignition such as:

- French Lavender
- Red Monkey Flower
- California Fuchsia
- California Lilac
- Sage

- Ornamental Strawberry
- Yellow Ice Plant
- Coreopsis
